Good Morning First Communion Families,

I hope you are well!

While it may seem crazy to think about, your child's First Communion is only 73 days away. In order to prepare for this very special day, each year we have a group class for both students and parents/guardians to learn about and prepare for the Sacrament of First Communion, as well as receive all the logistics and details regarding First Communion and the May Crowning. You may remember us doing this same thing prior to First Reconciliation.

Recognizing that everyone comes with very busy schedules, we have decided to have this year's group class take the place of the First Communion retreat originally advertised.

This year's group class is going to take place on Sunday, March 12 at 9:30 a.m. at the school. This is a mandatory class for all students planning to receive First Communion at Holy Name and at least one parent/guardian.

- FIRST COMMUNION: Saturday, May 13 at 11:00 a.m. at the church
- MAY CROWNING: Sunday, May 14 at 10:30 a.m. at the church
