### STEPS TO BOOK YOUR APPOINTMENT

- Click on the above link for your child's teacher
- Click on: "Next available appointment slot on October 21, 2021"
- Please sign up for ONE time slot to speak to your child's teacher by clicking on an available time that works for you. (Make sure you are in Eastern Time Zone on your calendar) **Middle School students with siblings in Middle School also please only book ONE slot as they are extremely limited**
- When signing up for more than one teacher remember to allow time in between each chosen time slot to log into the next Zoom meeting. Do not book back-to-back appointments.
- Once you have clicked on the selected time slot you would like to reserve please make sure to add your name and the student's name.
- Then click SAVE to confirm.
- You will receive an email **(to the email address you used to sign up for the appointment)** confirming the time slot you chose along with the Zoom Link, Meeting ID, and Passcode. If you need to cancel your appointment you can do so from the email confirmation you received by just clicking on NO under "Going" and you will be removed from that time slot.
- You will also receive an email confirmation **(to the email address you used to sign up for the appointment)** Wednesday October, 20th as well as 30minutes prior to your appointment.
